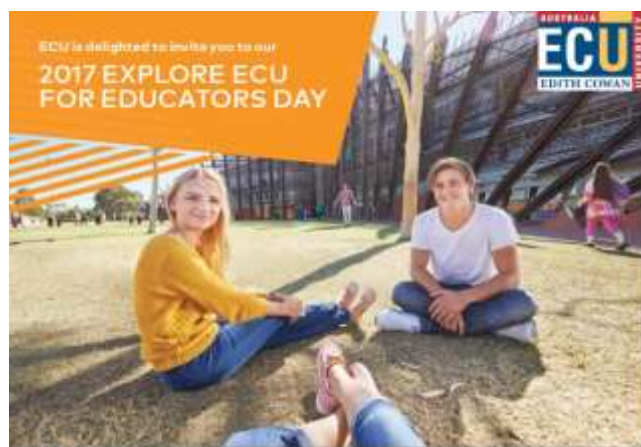

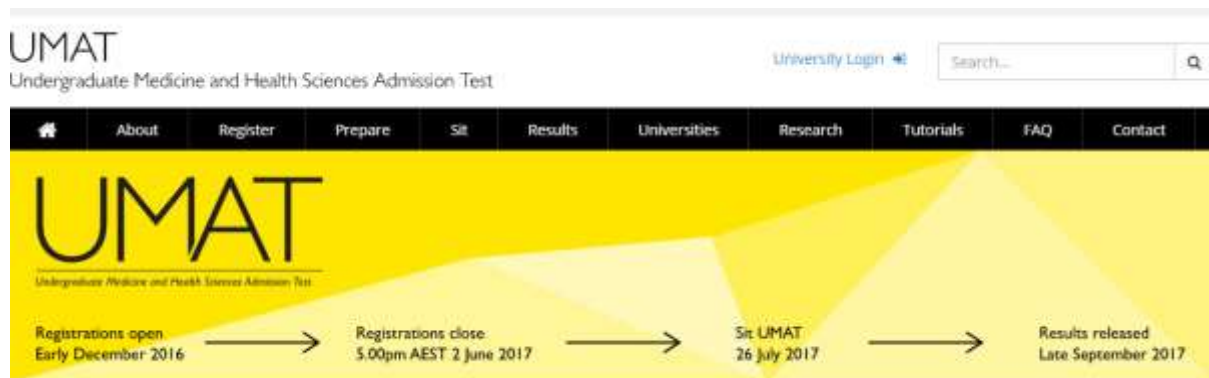

CQUni Perth Campus Schools Forum

Career advisors from a small group of metropolitan schools attended this forum on 22nd March.

Trevor Davison, the Associate Vice Chancellor of CQU in Perth started their Schools Forum by saying that CQU will be doing what they can to disrupt the status quo of tertiary education in WA. The Start Uni Now program does seem to achieve that.

The **Start Uni Now – SUN** program allows students in years 10 – 12 to undertake a university subject at CQU. Students need a letter from both their family and from their principal as part of their entry requirement and they can undertake one 12 week subject per semester. Subjects undertaken successfully are credited towards a degree.

Skills for Tertiary Education Preparatory Course seems similar to the preparatory courses offered by other universities.

The **Medical Sonography Course** began this year with 16 students. There were about 90 applicants. The ATAR cut off was 90.

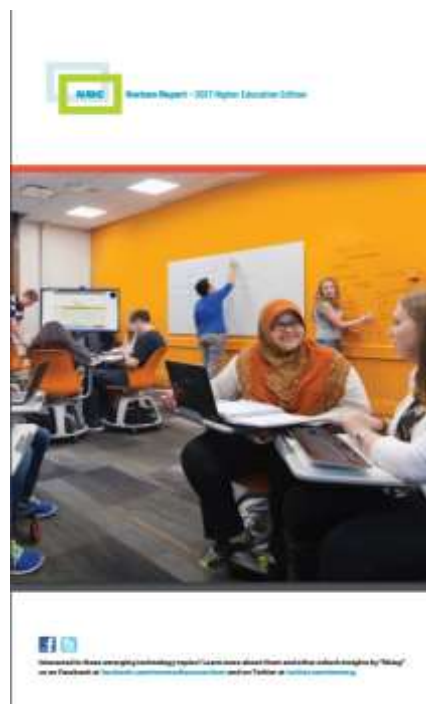
