

Kelmscott Senior High School Apprenticeship Link Program

The Kelmscott Apprentice Link Program is intended to assist transitioning students from school into an apprenticeship or paid work. It provides an introduction for students into the world of work-related opportunities within various trades in the local area or accessible by public transport.

There are a number of conditions for entry into the program which include:

- Acceptance into the program is dependent on an interview with student and parent/guardian.
- The grades from Year 10, behaviour and attendance at school will all be considered for eligibility.
- Students will have a fixed subject timetable over 5 days with 2-week block work placements at the end of each term.
