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CONTRIBUTIONS AND COMPULSORY CHARGES

Our school has always celebrated the support parents and families - particularly the financial support that families provide through the payment of school fees.

The Contributions and Charges that parents pay have a direct impact upon and increase the school's ability to provide valuable learning experiences for students.

The level of financial support requested of parents/caregivers for the education of your child, has been determined by the principal with the approval of our school board in accordance with legislation and authorities which include the School Education Act 1999 (WA) and Department of Education policies.



WHY IT IS IMPORTANT TO PAY THE CHARGES



As members of this vibrant school community, we all want the best for our children, and your voluntary school contributions help make that possible. They help supplement government funding, allowing us to provide a richer and more engaging curriculum.

These contributions directly support the delivery of high-quality education at Kelmscott Senior High School. They help fund essential resources like classroom materials, technology upgrades, and facility updates that go beyond the basics. Whether it's science equipment, art supplies, or class textbooks, your support ensures our students have the tools they need to thrive.

Contributions can also help to subsidise costs for incursions, excursions, enrichment programs, allowing us to offer experiences to students that would otherwise be unaffordable for the school to offer.

When families contribute, it ensures that all students, regardless of background, can benefit from the same high-quality resources and experiences. While the contributions are voluntary, they are a meaningful way to show your commitment to your child's education and to the broader school community.

WHAT ARE THE CHARGES?

Voluntary contributions for Years 7 to 10 are set by the Department of Education at \$235. Specialist programs attract **compulsory** charges in Years 7 & 8. Elective subjects & specialist programs in Years 9 & 10 attract **compulsory** charges dependent upon the chosen subjects.

Year 11 & 12 course fees are set by the school and are determined by the student's chosen courses. These course fees are **compulsory** and a 50% deposit payment can be requested.

PAYMENT OF CHARGES

Accounts will be provided to parents/caregivers in Term 4, 2025 to allow parents sufficient time to arrange payment. We recommend making plans now to settle the account before the commencement of the school year, with payments due no later than the end of Term 2 2026.

FLEXIBLE PAYMENTS

Whilst payments are due in Term 2, we understand that some families may find the payment of contributions and charges challenging. To ease the pressure on families, payment plans are available.

EDUCATION PERFECT & ONLINE SUBSCRIPTIONS

Education Perfect is an online learning platform utilised across all learning areas. Engaging interactive lessons are aligned with the curriculum, providing support for all students.

HEALTH HUB

The Health Hub assists the school in providing support to students in a number of ways including:

- Health packs for students in financial difficulty.
- Chaplaincy, nurse and psychological services.
- Building and works that support student wellbeing such as playgrounds, seating, gardens, games.
- Health and wellbeing days such as R U Ok Day.
- External services that support students.

LUNCH HUB

In partnership with generous donations from OzHarvest, our Health Hub aims to provide fresh fruit and lunches for students during both lunch breaks each day. The continuation of this valuable program relies on the ongoing generosity of our school community.

Your support helps us in maintaining and expanding this service, which currently provides over 100 meals each day, ensuring that every student can thrive at school.

TECH HUB

These funds support the ongoing upgrade, management, and maintenance of the school's computer network. They also contribute to training and provide essential supplies for students' printing and digital learning needs.

SCHOOL BUILDING & GROUNDS IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The school is dedicated to maintaining high-quality facilities that support student learning and wellbeing. Funds from the School Building & Grounds Improvement Program contribute to the ongoing upgrade, enhancement, and maintenance of school buildings and outdoor areas. These improvements ensure a safe, functional, and engaging environment for all students.

SCHOOL BUS REPLACEMENT

Kelmscott Senior High School aims to provide safe and reliable transport for students attending school events and activities. Contributions to the voluntary School Bus Replacement Fee help fund the purchase of a new bus, ensuring students can travel safely and comfortably to excursions, sporting events, and other school activities.

ADDITIONAL COST ITEMS

At Kelmscott Senior High School, excursions, incursions, camps, competitions and other activities are an integral part of our educational program. The charges listed are the maximum expected costs that cannot be exceeded and are applicable only to students enrolled in that specific subject. These items are optional and parents will be notified in advance of events and payment due dates.



SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME

The Western Australian Government through the Department of Education provides an allowance to assist eligible families with secondary schooling costs.

Parents/guardians must apply for the Secondary Assistance Scheme (SAS) each school year (annually) – applications do not carry forward to future years.

To be eligible for the allowance the parent/guardian must hold a Services Australia (Centrelink) or Veterans' Affairs card that represents a statement of income for the family.

The allowance consists of two components:

- \$115 Clothing Allowance paid directly to the parent/guardian or the school.
- \$235 Education Program Allowance paid directly to the school.

Application is made by the parent or guardian for student/s enrolled in Years 7–12 studying a full-time secondary course at a Western Australian public school.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Parent or Guardian must hold one of the following cards:

- Centrelink Health Care Card
- Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card
- Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card

Please Note: The only Veterans' Affairs Card that meets the criteria is a blue card that is issued annually and expires in December each year.

This card is income means tested. The parent/guardian must be the holder of a card that is valid sometime during first term. Students must be listed on claimant's card (except for some year 11 and 12 students). In this instance, the school must sight both concession cards. The only exception to this is when a student holds their own health care card and has been declared independent by Centrelink (e.g. Living Away from Home) in which case, a letter of confirmation from Centrelink must accompany the application.

The concession card must not be expired when applying for SAS. The allowance is paid up to and including the year the student turns 18 years of age i.e. students born in 2007 or before are ineligible in 2026.

CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES

Schools will receive the Education Program Allowance of \$235 for SAS recipients. This will be applied towards education program charges in the first instance, with any residual to be applied to the voluntary contribution (for years 7 to 10) or as negotiated with the parent/guardian (for years 11 to 12).

CLOTHING ALLOWANCE

The clothing allowance of \$115 will be paid to the parent/guardian unless indicated on the application form that you wish for it to be paid to the school. If payment is to be made to the parent/guardian, the payment will be deposited into the nominated bank account. It can take between 8 to 12 weeks to receive this payment.
